MONDAY 6

Please pray for the members of the PCC who have an extra meeting tonight to consider an independent safeguarding report (not directly related to the Bishops' Visitation). Pray for the Lord's sovereign and gracious work amongst us all as we start to address these weighty matters.

Pray today for 'Small Talk' – reaching out to preschoolers and their carers.

TUESDAY 7

Pray for the Small Groups and their leaders as a new term starts this week.
