- 5. What is the similar problem in Pergamum and Thyatira? (2v14-16, 20-23)
- 6. If you have time and desire: How do the stories of Balaam and Balak (Numbers 22-25 & 31:16) and Jezebel (1 Kings 16-21) help us understand the warning here?
- 7. Why is teaching which leads to eating food sacrificed to idols and sexual immorality so serious?
- 8. *Maybe a private question:* In what ways are we falling short of God's good design for sex and marriage?
- 9. What will repenting and not tolerating such teaching involve for us as individuals and as a church?
- 10. How do the descriptions of Jesus here help us receive these messages?
