PRAYER DIARY

"The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit" (Psalm 34:18)

MONDAY 17

Pray for Jim and Sonia Crossley, and their son Ted, as they begin their ministry at Christ Church Hillsborough and Wadsley Bridge where Jim has been appointed as Oversight Minister. Pray for the service of licensing and installation at his new church tonight and ask the Lord to go before Jim and the family as he takes up the task of leading God's people there.

Pray much for our PCC. There's no 'end of term' feel about tonight's agenda with vital issues such as finance, recruitment and General Synod to discuss.

TUESDAY 18

MONDAY 24

Pray for the ministry of Prison Fellowship, remembering especially the work of prison chaplains and asking for wisdom and discernment as they pastor those with especially complicated lives. Give thanks and pray too for opportunities to use the 'Christianity Explored Prison Edition' which meets the unique challenges of sharing the identity, mission, and call of Jesus with those serving time in prison.

TUESDAY 25

Give thanks for the work of 'Street Pastors' in Sheffield, bringing help and hope to those who frequent the City Centre at night, whether that be for work or leisure. Pray for safety for the teams, for good conversations about faith and for more helpers to come forward.

Pray too for another City Centre ministry – the 'Parish Nursing Project' based at St Matthew's, Carver Street, with registered nurses reaching out to promote the health of body, mind and soul of the members of a very diverse community.

WEDNESDAY 26

As many local churches return to the use of the 'Common Cup' for communion services, pray for wisdom for our leadership team as they discern the best way forward in this regard for us here at Fulwood.

THURSDAY 27

Praise God for good things happening at neighbouring churches including Christ Church Stannington (where people have joined from St Thomas Crookes), All Saints' Totley, where Ben Tanner (once a member our Youth Group) is the Vicar and All Saints' Ecclesall, where Godfrey Smallman and Simon Oatridge (both former members of Christ Church Fulwood) are part of the Staff Team.

FRIDAY 28

Praise God for God's provision and faithfulness over the past 10 months that Rachel Hopkins has served at Kompiam Hospital in Papua New Guinea. Pray that Rachel would now settle back well to life in the UK, and for guidance and discernment as she considers her next steps.

SATURDAY 29

Pray that this time with others involved in global student ministry will be a great encouragement for Anja in her own work with postgraduate students in the UK and Europe.

TUESDAY AUGUST 1

Give thanks to God for the Scriptures that teach, train and correct and in which is found the wisdom leading to salvation through Jesus Christ. Pray for all involved in the translation, distribution and production of the Bible worldwide, for The Bible Society, for Good News for Everyone and for Wycliffe Bible Translators. Pray that the Lord would be shaping his people by the Word that brings life and hope through Jesus, the living Word.

WEDNESDAY 2

Pray that, if any good comes out of the present controversy in the Church of England, it will be that God, in suffering errors to arise, will lead us to a closer and clearer definition of the truth and expose those who have "rebelled against the words of God and spurned the counsel of the Most High" (Psalm 107: 11).

THURSDAY 3

Pray for our Safeguarding Team – for Heather Charlton and Sally Hewson, our Safeguarding Officers, and for Anna Wade, dealing with administration and with the organisation of Safeguarding training. Pray that we, as a church, might be faithful to our commitment to promoting a safer environment and culture; to caring pastorally for those affected; to safe recruitment of workers; to responding promptly in all cases.

FRIDAY 4

Pray for the older ones amongst us who are prevented by frailty from enjoying the benefits of being part of a Church Family. Ask that each would know enduring grace and abiding faith to overcome their doubts and fears.
